

## MCA ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Association shall award up to two annual scholarship(s), in the amount of \$500.00 each, to the recipient(s) who meet the following criteria:

- A. Eligible students include those full-time students in good standing who have completed a semester of higher education. A minimum “C” average is required to apply for a scholarship.
- B. Scholarships are available to a member or child of a member in good standing with the Association.
- C. This financial gift will not be limited to students enrolled in a four year college. Graduate schools, vocational schools, junior colleges, military schools and other types of alternative continuing education are acceptable as well, contingent on approval of the Education Committee.
- D. Scholarships are merit based; however, every possible consideration shall be given to the student’s entire situation. Although this is a financial gift, it is not aimed exclusively at persons in a specific economic bracket.
- E. Emphasis shall be given to those students who express a desire to further their education in the insurance industry.
- F. Each candidate shall provide the following information:
  - 1. A copy of the most recent transcript reflecting at least a “C” average and that they are in good standing.
  - 2. A resume which shall include: educational background, work experience, community interests and personal interests.
  - 3. A statement explaining the student’s goals and plan for the future.
- G. The winner will be announced at the regular January meeting of each year, at which time a check will be presented.
